To avoid spreading aquatic invasive species

**BEFORE launching ... BEFORE leaving:**

- Remove aquatic plants and aquatic animals
  - Drain lake or river water away from landing
  - Dispose of unwanted live bait in the trash
- It's the Law... Do not:**
- Transport aquatic plants, zebra mussels, or other prohibited species on public roads
  - Launch a watercraft or place a trailer in the water if it has aquatic plants, zebra mussels or other prohibited species attached
  - Transport water from infested waters
