

# Schoolcraft Conservation District Student Scholarship Application

**Eligibility:** This scholarship is for high school seniors who **1)** attend Manistique High School, Jack Reque Alternative School, Big Bay de Noc School or are residents of Schoolcraft County attending another school **AND 2)** will be pursuing a certificate, associate's degree, or bachelor's degree in a natural resources field in the fall of 2022. **Application must be legible. Can be typed or handwritten.**

**Amount:** Up to two \$500 scholarships will be awarded. The scholarships will be paid directly to the students' college upon successful completion of their first semester and proof of enrollment in their second semester. Students will need to send a copy of their first semester grades and second semester schedule to the conservation district.

**Application Due Date: MARCH 11, 2022** (Must be turned in to MHS, Jack Reque, or Bay de Noc school office by this date OR postmarked by this date and mailed to Schoolcraft Conservation District, PO Box 250, Manistique, MI 49854) Winners will be notified by mid-May.
